I hope you ALL have a very Merry Christmas and a Happy, Healthy, Safe New Year.



Special Military Active & Retired Club (SMART), brings military veterans (active, retired, & honorably discharged) together to share camaraderie, travel, RVing, and to support our veterans. SMART members provide information for the military RV family, and support welfare programs for veterans while "Seeing the Country We Defend."

Recreational Therapy the S*M*A*R*T Way

Recreation is extremely therapeutic for those trying to recover from a hard week, month or tour of service. It serves to calm the individual and to replace the stimuli that cause stress. In other words, get out of the house and go somewhere new! For those with a trailer, camper or motorhome, it is as easy as joining a camping group. For military veterans, the logical group to join is called "SMART".

According to the American Therapeutic Recreation Association (ATRA), recreational therapy is a treatment service designed to restore, remediate and rehabilitate a person's level of functioning and independence in life activities, to promote health and wellness as well as reduce or eliminate the activity limitations and restrictions to participate in life situations caused by an illness or disabling condition.

"The Special Military Active & Retired Travelers" provides opportunities for them to gain the therapeutic conditions needed after serving in the military. Instead of being surrounded by the conditions causing stress, the camping group meets at RV Parks, bases, seashores, hills, etc...away from the "bustle of cities and daily problems." I have interviewed and maintained e-mail contact with about a dozen members of SMART located in several states. All of them praised the benefits they have received over the years of camping, traveling and meeting with other members.

Originally, I went to one of their outings (called "musters") thinking they would just sit around and tell war stories. Not one story over the four days of

playing cards, participation in games and eating at restaurants, potlucks and sitting near the pool!

As a former Clinical Psychologist, I was trained in and implemented many therapies. Most were in an institutional setting, university or hospital. But I must admit now....there is nothing like getting away from the stress-inducing scene...and going to a nice, warm gathering of people who enjoy the outdoors... away from it all! In essence, joining and participating in a recreational group among peers is both enjoyable and therapeutic.

Please forward this email to all veterans and spouses so they can be helped by the SMART activities.

We owe so much to our veterans who served in the National Guard, Navy, Air Force, Marines, Army, Coast Guard, etc...and the spouses who lost their partners in the military. We need to contact every one of them we care about to let them know about the SMART RV club.
