Information for AlfaSeeYas Race Rally

This is the 20th Anniversary Reunion for the Auto Club Speedway –it should be a great Race Rally with lots of fun activities throughout the weekend!

We will enter the California Speedway RV lot the morning of Thurs Mar 23, 2017 and depart the morning of Mon Mar 27. We will have a group of reserved spaces, so it is not necessary that we all arrive at the same time. (Note: if desired, you can depart the RV lot Sun night after the race – just figure the traffic will be very heavy for several hours after the race, as the adjoining street is one of the major track exits).

Directions:

From I-15 North or South: Take 4th Street Exit; go Eastbound to Etiwanda Ave; turn Northbound on Etiwanda to Napa Street; turn Eastbound on Napa Street (toward Green Gate 5); after about ½ mile, turn left into RV lot.
From I-210 East or West: Take I-15 South and follow above directions.
From I-10 East or West: Take I-15 North and follow above directions.

Details:

- We will be staying in the Speedway RV lot on Napa St – located near the Speedway Gate 5 - just West of the Western entrance to the track.
- This will be dry camping on a gravel/pressed dust treated surface
- RV spots measure approx. 20' X 40', plus additional nearby parking is available in the RV lot for towed/tow vehicles)
- Our group spaces will be adjoining - individual RVs can park multiple ways in/across their own space
- We have included in the registration fee a small charge, so we can purchase an additional RV space from the Speedway, in order to accommodate our group activities.
- Social activities, tables, chairs, canopies, flags, etc. are allowed in the RV area
- Pets are allowed in the RV lot – just make sure they are on a leash and you pick up after them
- Generators are allowed (and most everyone uses them) except for the quiet time of midnight to 6 am.
- Portable showers and restrooms are provided in the RV lot
- There may be a “honey wagon” and a fresh water truck on call, for a fee
- The RV lot has 24-hour Security
- There are no in and out privileges for RVs, but you can take your personal tow/towed vehicle in and out of the RV lot during the rally
- It is an easy walk to the speedway
 - Some folks bring bicycles to ride back and forth (just bring a lock to lock it to the

- track fence when at the Speedway).
- There is a free shuttle that goes periodically between the RV lot and track (although walking to/from the shuttle may be almost as far as just walking to the track!).
 - You will also be able to drive your tow/towed vehicle to the track and park it on Fri and Sat - but some of the parking may be just as far to walk to the track entrance as from the RV lot.
 - The cost for children is the same as for an adult. There are no lower age limits except for entrance to the pits: on Fri & Sat persons must be 18 years or older, on Sun persons under 18 years old are allowed and are free with a paid adult. At this time, we do not know if there is a lower age limit for the garage tour.
 - Fri practice sessions are General Admission (open seating). Our group will be in adjoining reserved seats for the Saturday and Sunday races.
 - In addition to all the track and race team souvenir vendors, there are many food and drink vendors located throughout the track. A few may be open Thurs, many more are open Fri through Sun. There is a list available on the California Speedway web site showing what can and cannot be brought in to the track (e.g., bags, coolers, etc.).
 - There is shopping (food and non-food) nearby the track RV lot – but not within walking distance. There are also many restaurants nearby the track RV lot – but also not within walking distance.
 - There are also many other free activities during race weekend at the track – such as the FanZone, entertainment, sponsor/vendor displays and exhibits, souvenir haulers, etc. – information on these will also be provided in the ticket packages. There will also be more info - such as the “2017 Auto Club Speedway Guest Guide” - available on the speedway web site: www.autoclubspeedway.com, as the race weekend gets closer.
 - If you have not attended a NASCAR race previously, you need to know that the cars are VERY LOUD – especially when in a group. We strongly advise you to bring hearing protection with you. A suggested option (at extra cost) is to rent an audio scanner at the track (usually with two headsets)—they allow you to hear the Motor Racing Network coverage of the race, as well as conversations between the drivers and their pits. They also provide good hearing protection. They are easy to rent (we got ours on Thurs when we attended the 2016 race), and easy to turn in after the Sun race ends. Cost is approx. \$50 for the whole weekend. There are also scanners with video available - at a greater cost.
 - The Leisure Coachworks (formerly Alfateers) Service Center is located across the street from the Speedway, on the Eastern side of the track.
 - They have invited us to take a tour of their facilities on Friday afternoon, after which we will have dinner with them at their facility. They will also have their parts department open late that afternoon if you have some purchases you would like to make. Probably best to contact them in advance to ensure they have what you need.
 - If you have work you would like them to perform before or after the Race Rally at their nearby facility, please contact them directly as soon as you can (909-428-6775) to make sure they can fit you into their schedule. If you do arrange to have work starting the Monday morning after the race, you might consider departing the track RV lot Sun evening, to park overnight

at Leisure Coachworks so they can start early Mon morning.

- There are numerous campgrounds in the area of the Speedway, plus an Elks Club (for those who are members) for you to stay at if you are traveling a long distance and want to arrive in the local area of the track before Thurs morning, or want to stay in the local area beyond Mon. The Speedway web site lists a number of them, plus you can refer to your own RV directories.
- In case of the race being postponed (e.g., delayed a day due to rain), in addition to the normal Speedway policy of honoring the race tickets on the postponed day, the RV lot will also stay open.

⁽¹⁾ Subject to change. Look for the most current schedule at the Wagon Masters' site.

⁽²⁾ The track will provide a timeline and parade route for the haulers - typically starting several miles from the track, and arriving at the track to enter the pits. There are normally several designated viewing spots along the route, but we found a great one is at the track just before they enter the pits.

⁽³⁾ A garage tour is normally included with the AAA race package – we will attempt to make reservations for all of us for Fri at about 1:00 pm. For the 2016 race, this worked out great – they were doing inspections on the Auto Club 400 cars and we were right amongst them!

We are not planning on “formal” morning coffee or snacks, nor specific night-time appetizers, as there are so many activities going on at the track. As we found out last time we did this race rally, very few rally attendees took advantage of rally site morning or evening activities. However, we intend to have a “social area” amongst the parked RVs, and there should be time to set up chairs and socialize in the mornings or evenings (in addition to being the site of the catered dinner on Sat night). For the catered dinner, we are planning on having the nearby Famous Dave's BBQ deliver, and we will serve the rally attendees.
