I want to give you a "heads-up" on some chapter activities planned for January 2019.

FMCA Western Area Rally

As we usually do, a group of us will be attending the FMCA Western Area Rally at Indio, California from January 8-13. If you want to park with our group at the Rally, **register for "25-30 Amp Electric" parking**. Registration is now open, either at fmca.com or by mail using the attached form.

We will be meeting at the Spotlight 29 casino in Indio on the night of January 7th (or early on the morning on the 8th) and going in to the Fairgrounds on the morning of January 8th. This is the day before the "official" start of the rally but gives us better parking and a chance to get settled before the start of activities. Electricity is usually available by mid-day Tuesday.

There is an additional \$25 charge for early arrival; however, if you sign up as a volunteer, this charge is waived. You can check the volunteer box when you register. Most of our members volunteer to serve as seminar monitors, which is pretty easy with a minimal time requirement. There is usually a short volunteers meeting Tuesday afternoon and a free volunteers dinner that night.
